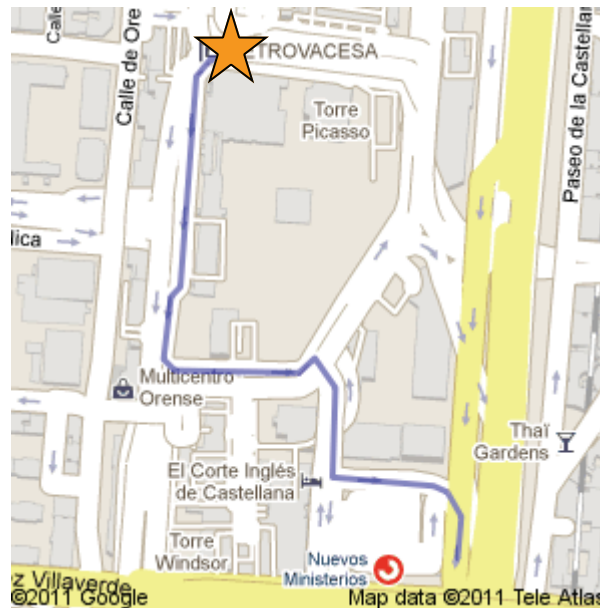




The project
